INDOOR AIR QUALITY



Dust, pollen, mold, and tobacco smoke can irritate the lungs. The quality of air inside our home is an important part of our health.

LEAD EXPOSURE



Homes built before 1978 that have cracking, chipping, or peeling lead paint can create lead dust; often a source of lead poisoning.

FIRE SAFETY





Smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors are some of the simplest resources that can keep our home safe and protected.

RESIDENTIAL INJURIES



Vulnerable individuals, such as babies, children or older adults, can be susceptible to trips, falls and injuries.

ASTHMA & ALLERGY



Pollution, animal dander, dust mites, aerosolized particles, etc., can be triggers for asthma and allergy related conditions.

PEST CONTROL



Cockroaches, bed bugs, mice, and other pests are a health concern in the home.
